At the General Assembly today (26th September 2012), Madagascar's Transitional President, Andry Rajoelina, called on the United Nations for continued international support for his Indian Ocean country as it approaches elections that are the final phase of a road-map to end a protracted political crisis.



"In accord with UN experts, Madagascar's electoral timetable has been officially promulgated with presidential elections set for 8 May, 2013", President Rajoelina told the 67th General Assembly on the second day of its annual General Debate.
